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Dear colleagues,

We would like to inform you about the ongoing **international registry on EOSINOPHILIC OESOPHAGITIS (EoE) IN ESOPHAGEAL ATRESIA**. Indeed eosinophilic esophagitis seems more frequent in esophageal atresia patients but its consequence in term of symptoms, anastomotic stenosis and treatment remain largely unknown. This study will further define patient characteristics, history, associated diseases, natural history of EoE in these patients, symptoms, rate of complications including development of stenosis, need for dilatation and response to treatment, and compliance by treating clinicians with current treatment guidelines for EoE.

Inclusion criteria are child aged 0-18 years at the time of inclusion and at the time of endoscopy:

- with ≥ 15 eosinophils/field on at least one esophageal biopsy
- with a repaired EA.

In practice, you will need to fill in a computerized data collection form (anonymous). It will take about 30 minutes for each patient.

If you are interested, do not hesitate to contact us, so that we can send you the study protocol and start the regulatory procedures (agreement between our 2 centers and approval by your ethics committee).
